

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission is conducting aquatic harvesting activities on Lake Istokpoga from March 30, 2009 to May 28, 2009. The harvesters will be working in four areas of the littoral zone marsh (yellow triangles) to remove tussock and associated organic material in an effort to enhance the littoral zone for the benefit of fish, wildlife and recreational users. Three harvesters will be used to remove the material and transport it to designated spoil islands located adjacent to each site.
